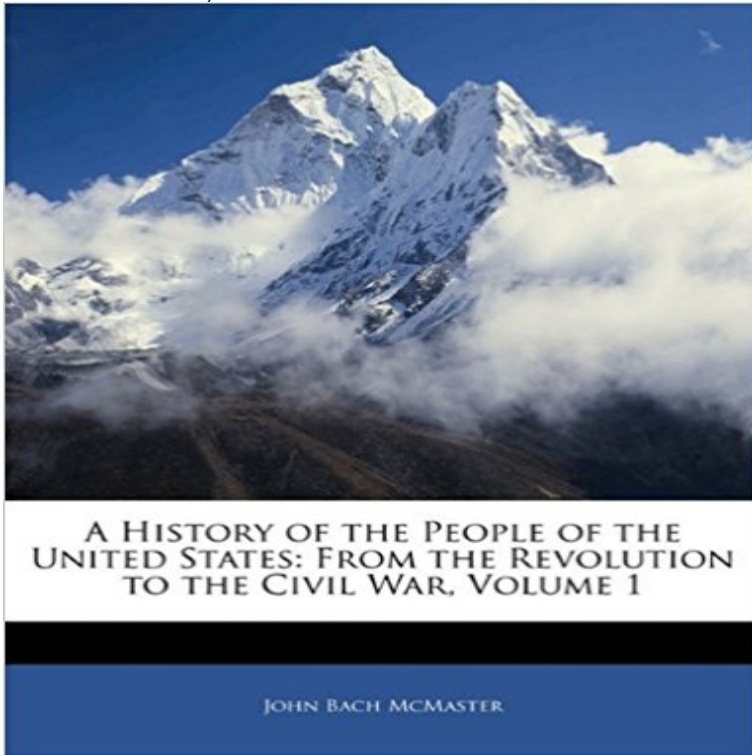


A History of the People of the United States: >From the Revolution to the Civil War, Volume 1
