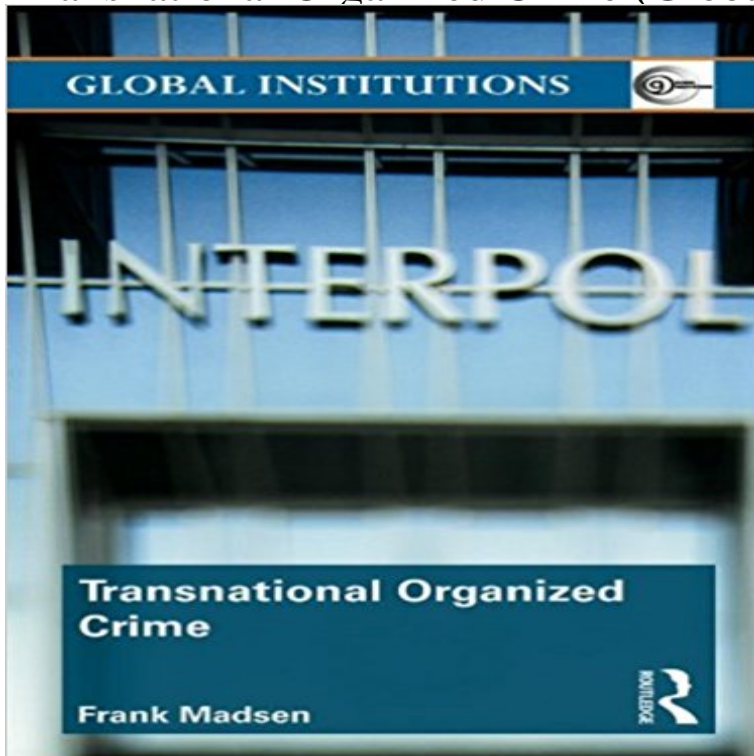


Transnational Organized Crime (Global Institutions)
